

RESOLUTION 6.2

EI MEMBERSHIP DUES

Proposed by SNES-FSU/France, SNESUP-FSU/France, SNUipp-FSU/France, OLME/Greece, UIL-Scuola/Italy, FLC-CGIL/Italy, ZNP/Poland, FENPROF/Portugal, ESTUS/Slovenia, FETE-UGT/Spain, STEs/Spain and EGITIM-SEN/Turkey

Original language: French

The 7th Education International World Congress

1. **Recognizing:**
 - a. that the current method for calculating individual membership dues is not entirely satisfactory in light of recent developments linked to the impact of the financial and economic crisis on the situations of member organizations;
 - b. that EI's budget must remain balanced, and revenue levels maintained, if not improved;
 - c. that there is a need to reconcile the number of members declared by member organizations and the actual number of members;
 - d. that there is a need for the Congress to decide the criteria applied and how their implementation for the purpose of granting arrangements for the payment of membership dues will be advertised.
2. **Taking into account** the general principles set out in Article 3 of EI's Articles of Association, with particular reference to democratic ideals.
3. **Mandates** the Executive Board to:
 - a. Conduct a thorough examination of the criteria to be used in order to reach a different method for calculating membership dues per member.
 - b. Conduct a consultation with member organizations, as a first step, in order to gather opinions and proposals.
 - c. Implement a Taskforce or working group, as a second step, whose objective will be to prepare a new proposal for the calculation of membership dues leading to a democratic rebalancing for 2018-2019. The Taskforce or working group will consist of 4 representatives from the Executive Board and one additional representative per region.
